April 16, 2008 – For the second consecutive year, the Major Artery Revitalization Committee (MARC) tries to run down a cure in the 29th annual Broad Street Run. This year they are raising funds for a local mother stricken with breast cancer.

In October of 2007, Kim Bartol (Martinelli), a 36-year-old, mother of three at Our Lady of Calvary School, found a malignant lump in her breast. Since then, she's endured a bilateral mastectomy and intravenous chemotherapy. Although continuing to work as an ultrasound technician at the University of Pennsylvania, the physical, emotional and financial burden on her and her children remains enormous.

“Although she's an Archbishop Ryan H.S. grad,” said MARC President John Byrne, who will be running in the May 4 race along with MARC Treasurer Christopher Creelman, “us Father Judge H.S. guys are always ready to lend a helping hand. Our schools may be athletic rivals but when it really matters and a community member needs some support, we're all on the same team.”
